DETAILED INFORMATION RELATING TO RECRUITMENT OF TECHNICAL STAFF FOR 01 (ONE) YEAR CONTRACTUAL BASIS AS PER THE NOTIFICATION NO. 2099-PL/PB/2G-06/08 (Pt.) DT. 18.06.15 OF HOME DEPARTMENT, POLICE ESTABLISHMENT BRANCH, GOVERNMENT OF WEST BENGAL

The Government of West Bengal has accorded sanction to the recruitment of 35 (Thirty five) posts of Technical Personnel on 01 (One) year contractual basis for manning interceptor boats in Coastal Police Stations under Coastal Security Scheme, Phase-II.

(A) The method of and the qualifications required for recruitment to different posts shall be as follows :

(1) Sub-Inspector (Technical) :

Eligibility :

Ex-Navy / Ex-Coast Guard / Ex-BSF (Water wing) / Ex-ITBP (water wing) Personnel.

Qualification :

- i. Chief Petty Officer / Petty Officer in the Navy, Seaman Branch only (Navigation, Communication, Gunnery, Anti-Submarine Warfare, Clearance Driver and Survey Recorders) [for Ex-Navy personnel].
- ii. Adhikari / Pradhan Navik in Coast Guard, GD Branch only [for Ex-Coast Guard Personnel].
- iii. 02 (two) years experience in B.S.F. (water wing) as Sub-Inspector [for Ex-BSF (water wing) personnel].
- iv. Sub-Inspector (Master) and Sub-Inspector (Engine Driver) [for Ex-ITBP (water wing) personnel]

Age:

Not exceeding 45 years as on 1st January, 2015.

(2) Asstt. Sub-Inspector (Technical) :

Eligibility:

Ex-Navy / Ex-Coast Guard / Ex-BSF (water wing) / Ex-ITBP (water wing) Personnel.

Qualification:-

- i. (a) Petty Officer in Navy, Seaman Branch only (Navigation, Communication, Gunnery, Anti Submarine Warfare, Clearance Driver and Survey Recorders) [for Ex-Navy personnel].
(b) Artificer III/IV, Mechanic III/IV, Mechanic (Power / Radio), Petty Officer Electrical Radio) in Navy in technical branch (non-aviation sailor only) [for Ex-Navy personnel].

- ii. (a) Pradhan Navik in Coast Guard, GD Branch only [Ex-Coast Guard Personnel].
(b) Yantrik / Uttam Yantrik in Coast Guard, technical branch only [for Ex-Coast Guard Personnel].
- iii. 03 (three) years experience in B.S F. (water wing) as Asstt. Sub-Inspector [for Ex BSF (Water wing) personnel].
- iv. Analogous Post in ITBP (water wing)

Age :- Not exceeding 45 years as on 1st January, 2015.

(3) Constable (Technical) :

Eligibility:-

Ex-Navy/Ex-Coast Guard / Ex-BSF (water wing) / Ex-ITBP (water wing) Personnel.

Qualification:

- i. Leading Seaman / Seaman-1 / Seaman-II in Navy equivalent, all branches) [for Ex-Navy personnel].
- ii. Uttam Navik / Navik in Coast Guard, only GD / Technical Branch [for Ex-Coast Guard Personnel].
- iii. 03 (tree) years experience in B.S.F, (waterwing) as Constable [for Ex-BSF (water wing) personnel].
- iv. Constable (Crew) [for Ex-ITBP (water wing) personnel]

Age:-

Not exceeding 45 years as on 1st January, 2015.

(B) Mode of Recruitment :

Applications in prescribed format is invited from, male citizens of India who have served in Indian Navy / ICG / BSF (waterwing) / ITBP (Water wing) and holding the posts as mentioned for recruitment to Coastal Police Stations (Technical Wing). Eligible candidates are required to appear for a personality test of 20 marks for all ranks of Technical Wing.

(C) Pay and Allowances : (As approved vide G.O. No. 1009-PL/PB-2G/06/08 dtd. 25th March, 2013) :

(D) Terms and Conditions :

1. The contract appointment would be for a period of 01 (one) year extendable upto a period of 5 (Five) years with provision for yearly performance review with effect from the date of filling up of the posts or till regular recruitment is made whichever is earlier.
2. They would be entitled to a consolidated remuneration only on monthly basis as noted above.
3. Entitled for 14 (fourteen) days Casual Leave in the year.
4. Leave availed in excess of 14 (fourteen) days shall be deducted from his salary.
5. Provision of medical facilities and insurance will be considered, if necessary.
6. Appointment will be finalized only for physically and medically fit candidates.
7. The contract appointment is purely temporary.

(E) How to apply:-

Willing candidates may download the Application Form from West Bengal Police website (policewb.gov.in) and get it printed on 120 gsm A4 size paper and fill in the same and affix stamp size photograph on the space provided for. Candidates have to enclose certificates as a proof of Date of Birth, Educational Qualification, Discharge Certificate issued by the previous employer and send the same by post to "The Chairman, West Bengal Police Recruitment Board, Araksha Bhavan (5th Floor), Block-DJ, Sector-II, Salt Lake City, Kolkata-700 091". Candidates must superscribe the envelope containing the application forms with words "DO NOT FOLD DOG EAR OR OTHERWISE DAMAGE THIS ENVELOPE OR ITS CONTENTS". The candidates shall have to pay Rs. 150 (Rupees one hundred fifty) only as examination fees in the form of **Indian Postal Order (IPO)** or **Demand Draft** from State Bank of India (**SBI**) only drawn in favour of West Bengal Police Recruitment Board **payable at Kolkata**. Application Forms with Demand Draft **other than** from **SBI** shall be **rejected**. Candidates from **Schedule Caste/Schedule Tribe** category **need not pay** Application fees. However, the SC and ST candidates from other States will be treated as Unreserved Category and need to pay the requisite fees. The filled in Application Form must reach this office by **20/11/ 2015**.
